
CHANGES IN SEASON II

Teacher - Carol Miller

Come Join The Flock!

Flock of flying geese, that is. Join me in creating your own Changes in Season II quilt by Scott Flanagan of 4th and Main Designs. Scott designed the pattern and the fabrics for this quilt. It's 60" by 86", so it just might be the perfect size for a special man in your life as a Christmas gift. Scott's fabrics are an unusual mixture, and the Flying Geese blocks have a fun but easy twist to them! Most of the blocks are 5.5-inch squares, so the sewing flies along fast! (Yes, pun intended.) Plus, you will be guilting for a cause. Scott has Spasmodic Dysphonia, and 10% of all sales of this fabric collection and the pattern will be donated to support Dysphonia International research into treatment and cures. Edwards does have Scott's fabrics from this collection. in stock. This guilt would look absolutely terrific in autumnal colors from your own stash, if you prefer. If you do decide to join us in this class, I recommend that you do not cut the quarter square triangles ("D" in the pattern) from each of the assorted prints until we meet for the class.

There will be a charge of \$12 for the pattern, payable at time of class.



COLLAGE CLASS

Teacher – Dawn Wolf

You will learn how to apply Steam-A-Seam 2 to your fabric. This double-sided adhesive will make your fabric into sticker form which allows you to collage in layers without pinning! Dawn will demonstrate several ways to do collage designs, this will vary depending on the size of project. She will show you several ways to finish your project.

There will be a charge of \$7.00 payable (cash) at the time of the class for the kit.

Purchase prior to class: Edwards will have a 20% coupon for members needing supplies for this day! * Whatever Wreath pattern #52 (Laura Heine mini pattern) The Wreath Pattern will be in the hold drawer for Guild members- Check with Edwards Staff.

Bring To Class:

- * 1/2 yard of 24" Steam-A-Seam (purchase more if you plan to do extra projects)
- * Applique Pressing sheet minimum size 13"x17" or larger (several styles available) or Precision Fusing Mat
- * 14"x14" piece of Backing Christmas colors or related fabric Red Binding is included in kit!
- * 14"x14" Batting your choice NOTE- I used double batting for more loft
- * Masking or painters' tape 1" wide
- * Iron that can steam
- * Ironing mat
- * Rotary Cutter & Ruler
- * Cutting Matt
- * Black Sharpie
- * Thread I used machine embroidery thread light silver, and red and cotton green thread.

You could also use white. If you do not want to free motion- bring invisible thread

- * 1/2 yard of 24" Steam-A-Seam (purchase more if you plan to do extra projects)
- * Applique Pressing sheet min. size 13"x17" (several styles available) or Precision Fusing Mat OPTIONAL
- * Sharp pointy scissors Blue Handled Karen Kay Buckley work fabulously, highly recommend!
- * Invisible thread I use this when I grid quilt my projects.
- * Sewing machine if you wish to quilt in class you will need sewing foot and Optional free motion foot



SCRAPPY TABLE TOPPER WORKSHIP

Teacher – Laura Jackson

At this workshop, you will learn to make a strip pieced Spider Web table topper that showcases your unique fabric scrap collection! This workshop is perfect for quilters of all levels who are looking to make use of their fabric scraps in a creative and structured way. Additionally, Laura will share her method of organizing scraps. If scraps are organized, you are more likely to use them! Don't miss this opportunity to learn how to declutter your fabric stash and to create something beautiful!

What to Expect:

- **Scrap Organization Demonstration:** Watch a live demonstration on techniques to sort and fold your fabric scraps efficiently.
- Hands-On Quilt Block Construction: Bring your own pre-cut scraps and background fabric, and use them to create a stunning strip quilt block.
- Finished Project: Complete the top of a pieced table topper ready to quilt home.

What to Bring:

- Precut Scraps: Please bring your fabric scraps already cut into the following sizes:
 - o Lengths between 1" and 2" wide
 - Sub-cut lengths into 4" and 2.5" pieces
- Precut Background Fabric: Bring 4 squares of background fabric, each cut to 9.25".
